Kentucky State Regulated Requirements for Childcare First Aid Kits

Kentucky:

In Kentucky, childcare centers must adhere to specific regulations regarding first aid kits to ensure the safety and well-being of children. Here are the key requirements:

1. Number of Kits:

- Each childcare center must have at least one first aid kit on each floor and in each building used by the children.

2. Contents of First Aid Kits:

- Adhesive bandages
- Sterile gauze pads
- Adhesive tape
- Scissors
- Tweezers
- Digital thermometer
- Disposable gloves
- Antiseptic wipes
- Cold pack
- First aid manual

3. Accessibility and Maintenance:

- First aid kits must be kept in a location that is easily accessible to staff but out of reach of children
- The contents of the kits should be regularly checked and replenished as needed
